The hotels

Surrounded by soaring mountain peaks, the majestic Victoria Glacier and a glistening emerald lake, the iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise hotel is located in Alberta's Banff National Park, 15 minutes from the resort. The lake is accessible from the hotel.

The Banff Springs Hotel offers exceptional views of the Canadian Rockies. Both hotels feature hot tubs, fitness facilities, onsite restaurants and complimentary internet.

The resorts

With a vertical rise of 3250 feet (991 meters), 145 marked runs and a total of 4200 acres, Lake Louise is one of the largest resorts of North America and as a stop of the annual World Cup tour; it is one of the most exciting. All terrain is served by modern lifts.

No matter what your ability, you will find yourself at home. At the top of each lift you will find either a green or a blue run down, and if you are into blacks and double blacks, there is no shortage whatsoever.

With an average annual snowfall of 180 inches per year, there is no shortage of snow, which combined with March temperatures make for perfect conditions. And for those that are hungry or thirsty, 11 restaurants and watering holes serve the mountain.

Banff Sunshine sits high on the Continental Divide in the heart of Banff National Park just 15 minutes' drive from the cozy mountain town of Banff. Three sprawling mountains provide breathtaking site lines, uninterrupted by any signs of civilization beyond the resort boundaries.

The resort features more than 3,300 acres of skiable terrain, ranging from gentle beginner runs all the way up to extreme big mountain runs. Sunshine's very own Delirium Dive has been named one of the 10 top off-piste destinations in the world.

Family-friendly Mt. Norquay offers outstanding conditions for beginner, intermediate and advanced skiers and riders. Just minutes from the Town of Banff, Mt. Norquay offers the only night skiing in Banff National Park, including a fully lit terrain park and tube park along with snowmaking across 85% of the terrain.

Other winter activities

Lake Louise is a cross country paradise where pristine mountain and wilderness set the stage for a unique outdoor experience. From the doorsteps of the hotel right into the wilderness, the variety is more than can be explored in one week.

However, Lake Louise and Banff are not just for skiers and snowboarders but offer all kinds of winter activities. Skating, dog sledging, snow shoeing, snow tubing and ice climbing are just some of the options right at the doorstep.
